1. Introduction

- Paul opened up by introducing the idea of what he did for the baselines. Courtney asked about funding and annual amounts, but it's dependent on outside funding. Shaina included in narrative that funding is source dependent.

2. Scenarios/Measurable Goals/Costs

- The spreadsheet covers no till, cover crops, tilled wetlands whereas SAM covers the remaining BMPs outside of the spreadsheet tool. The costs came from the SAM builder numbers
- Paul focused on lakes and reduction needed for them
- The group would like to remove 50% of the effort from the Shell Rock and Winnebago pour points and move them to the Fountain and Albert Lea Lake sections.
- Also move from 10% to 15% as an approach to adding more to the upstream areas.
- We might get questioned on moving everything to Fountain and Albert Lea Lake but it is defensible by our priority areas.
