Agenda:

1. Introduction

- Paul opened up by stating the work that he completed from the last meeting. He mentioned where we are going next and went over the agenda

2. Scenarios Results

3. Finalize Draft Targeted Approaches

- Paul updated water storage. SAM cropland shows wetlands. Water storage is in the restored wetlands. Tools and assumptions will be explained in the dialog.
- Paul clarified the \$/year and showing high to low cost effectiveness. Went over watershed output vs table form. The group liked the watershed view and BWSR thinks it is targeted enough.
- There will be 5 maps for each of the BMP's per subwatershed. Ended up going with map to track the whole subwatershed, makes reporting easier.
- Andy asked about funding. Rumors are funding is taken away if you are not completing your work. BWSR said if that was an option, it would be a last resort option, but BWSR hasn't landed on an answer yet.
- Dalton was to look at questions regarding flooding and get back to Paul
- TMDL Lakes get reduction, only say maintain for the lower lakes. As opportunities arise we will target those lakes. We are only added Chl-a and Secchi as supporting material.
- We are adding Credit Trading to B1.
- Courtney is finding current level of effort on enhancing District properties.

- There are no comments on groundwater
- Need to get info from Andy regarding feedlots
- Include Fountain Lake Habitat following the Dredging project.
- Courtney reference LSOHC plan for habitat for any additional projects.
- Courtney will find the lbs. of rough fish based on lakes of high importance.
- Invasive might be double dipping, make sure not to double dip when reporting.
- Goal 2 for invasive bullet point was changes to number of invasives targeted based on habitat projects already been completed. Named to the higher priority goals.
