Agenda:

1. Introduction

- Paul opened up the Zoom meeting and gave a quick update on what we will be discussing today. That includes looking at the implementation table and seeing what we are missing and move into the geographical approach. We will identify projects that we don't have; we are not looking at the measure just yet, but the practices itself to help the issue.

2. Review Implementation Table Projects

- Discussion started by going through each project one by one
 - a. A1 – Rachel would like to see a rewording of ‘administer county ditch system’ so Paul adjusted that. Water storage and wetlands were added to all locations. Steve brought up reporting and said the city takes elevation data when roads are closed, they will maintain that data gathering. Paul will look into if HSPF will look into water storage
 - b. A2 – It was discussed to remove the alum treatment facility but it is staying. Streambank restorations are added the Shell Rock River location and wetland restorations are added throughout. The TMDL implementation table was brought up and Paul will make sure those projects are included. Feedlots are being removed from the Winnebago. Cover Crops are added across the board. Surface water soil health practices language will be finessed. Paul again mentioned HSPF for water impoundments/wetland restorations.
 - c. B1 – Targeting on private buffers, can be a targeted project
 - d. B2 – Add a survey to the implementation table regarding soil health. Add soil health principles throughout.
 - e. C1 - Targeted acquisitions and conservation easements were added throughout.
 - f. C2 – Vegetation management was added throughout

g. C3 – GRAPS implantation table will be looked at and added into this section throughout the locations. Goal 2 – move non-compliance into compliance was added.

h. D1 – Add habitat structures for Fountain and Shell Rock locations. Some language was moved to the invasive species section.

i. D2 – Not much of an issue more focused on prevention.

3. Geographic Targeting Approach

- While doing agenda item number 2, the geographic locations were discussed at the same time, and practices were placed in the applicable geographic locations.
